**ITEM #1: What are the reimbursement rates to the current vendor for all three years of the current contract for all modalities of transport?**

Contract price is attached from the last award, #PUR-1066 awarded by the Washington County Commissioners.

**ITEM #2: Regarding the response time criteria, and payment for failure to abide by the terms, are there provisions for poor weather conditions, and extended response times as a direct result of those conditions? If so what are they?**

For weather conditions – If the weather conditions are very bad, the Washington County Health Department determines whether the rides are cancelled or rescheduled. Our Dialysis patients are usually brought in earlier or reschedule for the next day.

If the delay would be because the contractor just cannot get there in time for normal conditions, then it is up to the contractor to sub-contract so that rides can be completed on time.

If an appointment is cancelled as a result of the client arriving at their appointment late, the ride will not be paid for as the medical appointment was not able to be kept.
